All candidates must have a strong commitment to research and teaching at all levels. The department currently offers the B.S., degree in Information Science with plans to offer the M.S., and Ph.D. degrees in the future. Faculty in Information Science presently participate in Master's and Doctoral programs in Applied Science through the Applied Computing option and hold a joint appointment with the graduate Department of Applied Science. A Ph.D. in Information Science, Computer Science or a related field is required. We are particularly interested in candidates that can contribute to our research programs in network security and streaming media.
